CAMP SUMMARY

Each camper either brings their own mini or pony for the week or they may use one of our minis free of charge. They are responsible for all care of the horse for the week including stall cleaning daily and bathing. We will focus on horsemanship and trick training. They are learning our training techniques that include clicker training, targetting and marking to teach tricks such as fetch, laying down, bowing, smile and spin. Throughout the week they will put together their own freestyle routine, including picking their own music and choreographing. On Friday, we will have a performance showcase in the covered arena for family and friends!

FAQ

Is the age rule firm?

Generally, open to 10-17. Possibly younger kids are accepted if they have been in our program before or they are experienced with horses.

Will my horse have turnout?

Yes, we have private turnout paddocks or shared if your horse prefers a friend.

Where are they stalled?

They will all be together in the Equilibrium Barn at TerraNova right where all the camp action is!

Is there an afterhours pickup/drop off available?
